2. When you read a text, you sometimes find a word that you don't know. You can use the reading strategy **clarifying** to find out what this word means, without using a dictionary. This is because often the text gives you clues to find out the meaning of this word.

EXPLANATION

Reading strategy **clarifying**:

- 1) you use the **context** to try to find out what a word means
- 2) you check if you already know a **part of the word**, or if the word looks like a word you know in **another language**
- 3) you think about the main subject of the text and what you **already know** about it
- 4) you can look it up in **a dictionary** if you aren't able to work out the meaning of the word
